QUALIFIED APPLICANTS:

- Must be a born-again believer in Jesus Christ; be involved with a Christian church of like faith and practice; and agree with the philosophies of Laurens Academy.
- Have a commitment to the mission, philosophy, goals, and objectives of Christian schooling as expressed by Laurens Academy.
- Bachelor's degree in elementary education or subject content is required.
- Candidates with experience in teaching is preferred.
- Strong communication and presentation skills are required.
