

COVID Policy as of January 2022

If a student/staff member tests positive for COVID, they must quarantine for 5 days. They may return if symptoms have improved and they have been fever free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medicines.

If someone in the household tests positive for COVID:

1- If the student/staff member living in the home is vaccinated or has tested positive for COVID in the last calendar year, they may attend school.

2- If the student/staff member does not meet vaccination or prior COVID requirements yet are **able to isolate from the COVID positive individual,** they may quarantine for 5 days from last contact with the individual and may return if symptom free.

3- If the student/staff member does not meet vaccination or prior COVID requirement and **cannot isolate from the COVID positive individual,** they must quarantine for 10 days (5 days of the positive individuals quarantine and 5 additional days) and may return if symptom free.

If a student/staff member or someone in the household has symptoms, has been tested, and is awaiting test results, please follow the appropriate quarantine protocol until test results are received.

Please call the office and let us know if your child(ren) are having to quarantine. We need to mark the attendance appropriately within the system and notify teachers of anticipated return dates.

When returning from quarantine, students must check in through the office and provide a signed "COVID Return Statement" confirming that the student/staff member has quarantined for the required days, currently has no symptoms or has diminished symptoms, and has been fever free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medicines.
